MUFTI DENIES CHARGES

Says He Never Plotted Against Jews With Germans

CAIRO, Egypt, May 12 (P)-Haj Amin el Husseini, former Mufti of Jerusalem, denied today charges that he had worked with the Germans in a policy aimed at the extermination of the Jews.

Replying to accusations made against him in connection with the United Nations' debate on Palestine, he said: "I appeal to the American nation to liberate itself from Zionist propaganda, which intends to corrupt relations between America and the Arabs and Moslem world for the Zionists' sake alone."

He said he had never worked for any foreign nation but only for the interest of Palestine.
