Egypt Announces Invasion

CAIRO, Egypt, May 13 (Reuters)—"Egyptian army forces will begin moving across the Palestine frontier at one minute past midnight Friday," the Egyptian Government stated tonight.

The statement was made at a press conference by Abdel Razek el Sanhoury Pasha, Minister of Education.

Senior Egyptian army officers today flew to El Arish on the Palestine frontier, where a military conference was held to plan the disposition of Egyptian army units along the frontier.

Prime Minister Mahmoud Fahmy Nokrashy Pasha said earlier tonight: "We have entered the decisive phase of the Palestine question."

The Egyptian Army, in which service is nominally compulsory, is believed to number about 40,000.
