

EGYPT SEIZES 400 IN ZIONIST DRAGNET

Anti-Security Suspects Are
Linked With Communists—
Syria Votes War Funds

CAIRO, May 15 (AP)—The Under-Secretary of the Interior announced today that 400 "Communists and Zionists" were being rounded up in the Cairo, Alexandria and Port Said areas and were being placed in detention camps at Cairo and Alexandria. He said most of those rounded up were "Communists."

Officials described the round-up as a security measure.

Steel helmeted police patrolled Cairo's streets under Egypt's martial law.

The weekly newspaper Akhbar el Vom said that King Farouk sent a message to Ahmed el Mawawee Bey, Commander in Chief of the invading Egyptians and to three Egyptian staff officers attached to Trans-Jordan King Abdullah's supreme command, saying:

"God is with us, fight with us—victory will be ours by God's will."

The Under-Secretary of the Interior announced that a British officer, Arthur Delaney, would be in charge of censorship at the Marconi Company's transmission offices. Mr. Delaney was in charge of Anglo-Egyptian censorship here during the second World War.
