CAIRO, May 16—The police continued today to round up persons in Egypt known for their Zionist or Communist tendencies. In the latter category both non-Jews and a few Egyptians, including women, are being held. Several hundred are under arrest and have been interned.

Although riot squads are patroling Cairo and other principal cities the situation is quiet throughout Egypt. Special police precautions have been taken to protect Jewish property and synagogues.
