EGYPT SEIZES CARGO

Says Goods Were En Route to Israel-Mobilizes Drivers

ALEXANDRIA, Egypt, May 18 (P)—Egyptian authorities today confiscated 250 tons of goods they said were en route to Israel aboard the Norwegian vessel Nordkyn.

The Nordkyn arrived this morning from the United States, also carrying a cargo for Alexandria. The confiscated goods were reported to include automobiles, machinery, oil, iron, tin and canned food.
