Move on From Bethlehem

CAIRO, Egypt, May 18 (UP)—Arab Legion troops marched into hallowed Bethlehem today. They moved into a police post in Central Bethlehem close to the Church of the Nativity.

Bethlehem and Jerusalem are in what would have been an international neutral zone under the United Nations partition plan for Palestine.

A Legion force north of Jerusalem was a formidable one, composed of the pick of King Abdullah's army, with full war equipment. Its advance position is Jewish Atarot, six miles north of the Holy Citys where the Kollundia airport is situated.
