## Saudi Arabians in Line

CAIRO, Egypt, May 18 (UP)—Saudi Arabian troops are lighting alongside Egyptian forces in southern Palestine, bringing to six the number of Arab States whose troops have joined the war against Israel, it was announced today. Entry of Saudi Arabian troops into the Palestine war was disclosed in an exchange of telegrams between King Ibn Saud of Saudi Arabia and King Farouk of Egypt. Only Yemen of the seven Arab states so far has failed to an-

nounce its troops in action against the Jews. Observers believe this may be because Yemen has severe

internal difficulties.
