## Your Excellency.

We sincerely hope this plea will be answered soon, and that we will have the great pleasure of your kind help and corpperation. We have very goxal memories of Egypt and of the Egyptian people and culture. We look forward to renewing the warm relationship with the Egyptian people we had in the past when we were living in Egypt. Many of us who have returnel to visit have been overwhelmed by the traditional Egyptian hospitality.

As you can imagine, the Torah scrolls (Scfarim), the religious and sccular books, the community records located at the Rabbinates (Cairo and Alexandria), and our entire cultural heritage lefi in Egypl, from the time of our ancestors tis the present, are all very dear to us. The fact that they are rot accessible to us, or to scholars who would study them for posterity, gives us much sorrow.

We have a suggestion that we hope you will kindly consider: Transfer these Jewish artifacts to an acadenic institution in New York, where they would be accessible to all. Scholars from all over the world would then be able to study the documents. This action would also give greal comfort to the Camilies who originally donated these items to be used in a synagogue on a perpetual basis. Naturally, we are ready to pay for their transfer. We suggest to leave two Torah scrolls in cach synagoguc for tourists who might wish to worship there on the Sabbath and holidays.

Tast but not least, the renewal of the warm relationship between the Jews from Egypt and the Egyptian people could be a model for the future. It would allow many young Jews in the Diaspora to appreciate their historical connection to Egypt. It would also hasten friendly and peacetul relations between Arabs and Jews in the entire Middle

East.
