

U. S. Action on Israel Criticized in Egypt;

CAIRO, May 16 (AP)—President Truman's recognition of the new State of Israel was criticized today by the Egyptian press.

Al Ahram, influential Arabic language newspaper, said that the recognition gave no consideration to friendly relations of the United States with Arab countries.

It said that official circles were astonished and added: "Never before in history did such a recognition come so quickly. It will go as quickly—when existence of the new State ends."

Al Misri said Russia rather than the United States had been expected to recognize a Jewish state.

"America shapes her policy on the basis of fear of Russia's taking the opposite stand, whatever the results may be," it said. "Let

America, the home of Washington and Lincoln, recognize criminal gangs."
