

SAYS BRITAIN FIGHTS JEWS

Agency Official Charges British Officers Planned Attack

LONDON, May 17 (AP)—A Jewish official asserted today that Britain "has begun to wage undeclared war against the State of Israel."

S. Z. Shragai, executive member of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, said that British officers with the Trans-Jordan Army had helped to plan the Arab invasion.

He said that the British promised to remove the Arab Legion from Palestine before giving up the mandate. British planes are being used by Egypt, Mr. Shragai said, to bomb Tel Aviv "and peaceful Jewish settlements."

The Foreign Office denied the charge.
