Egypt Seizes Suez Canal Cargoes

PORT SAID, Egypt, May 22 (AP).

—Egyptian authorities confiscated today cargoes of two vessels, which, the Egyptians said, were en route to Palestine Jews from Australia. The ships, which had just come through the Suez Canal, were the Cape York, carrying 9,035 tons of flour, and the Marandura, carrying 5,000 tons of maize and canned goods and 5,000 bales of fodder.
